SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) Eligibility Requirements

In order to receive Food Stamps, you must:

- **Submit a SNAP application;**
- **Complete a quick telephone interview with a case worker;**
- **Meet basic eligibility rules and income limits.**

If you meet the following guidelines, you may be eligible for Food Stamps:

- **You are a U.S. citizen or legal permanent residents of at least 5 years;**
- **You are a Missouri resident;**
- **You meet gross monthly income guidelines:**

4	\$2,790	\$646
5	\$3,269	\$768
6	\$3,748	\$921

8	\$4,708	\$1,164
Each Additional Member	+\$479	+\$146

You may qualify if your income and other resources are under certain limits. New changes to the food stamp program have increased the maximum income limits, allowed a higher utility deduction, and have eliminated some assets from the calculation.

You can have a car, a house, and/or some savings and still be eligible. If you are undocumented, and have children who are US citizens, you can apply for food stamps on their behalf.
